Chapter 15 Agriculture A General Information Insecticides, chemicals, fertilizers, soil conditioners, seeds and seedlings used solely in the production for sale of farm, grove, vineyard or garden products are exempt from the Fuel used in farm machinery and farm tractors used in planting, cultivating or harvesting
